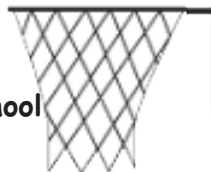
## ELKS FREE THROW CONTEST

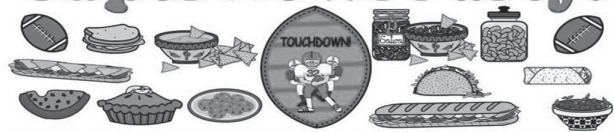

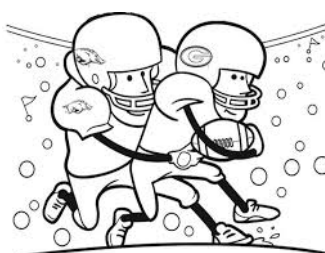
- Starting January 5th all Friday night dinners will be a charge of \$7.00, including the Anniversary Steak Night Dinner.
