- The Elks is an American fraternal order founded in 1868 by Charles Viviane originally as a social club in New York City.
- Until 1973, the national constitution of the Elks lodge restricted membership to white men.
- The Elks was traditionally an "all-male fraternal order" but in July 1995 a vote at the Elks National Convention passed to remove the word "male" from the national membership requirements.
- The Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks (BPOE) is organized on five levels: the National or "Grand" level, the Regional level, the State level, the District level and the Local level.
- The Elks have a network of nearly 2,000 lodges in communities all over the country.
- Estimated, there are over 850,000 current Elk members nationwide.
