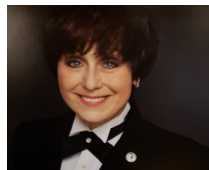
A Message from Our Exalted Ruler

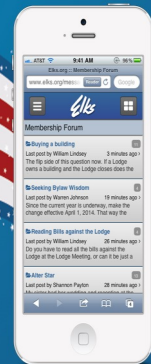
