There will be a \$50 prize given to the winner of the best wing. 2nd place gets a sweet Budweiser commemorative stein.


Make any flavor of wing you want. There are no limitations here. We also need 3 judges to take it seriously. If you would like to be a judge contact Nathan at 307-534-6765.

The Lodge continues to run Queen of Hearts as a fundraiser for our building projects and other needs such as Hoop Shoot, Soccer Shoot, Veterans Dinner and many other lodge and community activities.
