The Trustees / House Committee have determined that anyone that signed an E-mail Authorization Form will not receive the newsletter by postal mail.

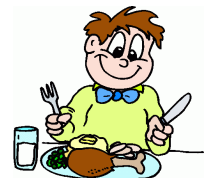
You have the following three options for newsletter delivery: 1) postal mail; 2) e-mail; or 3) both postal mail and e-mail.
