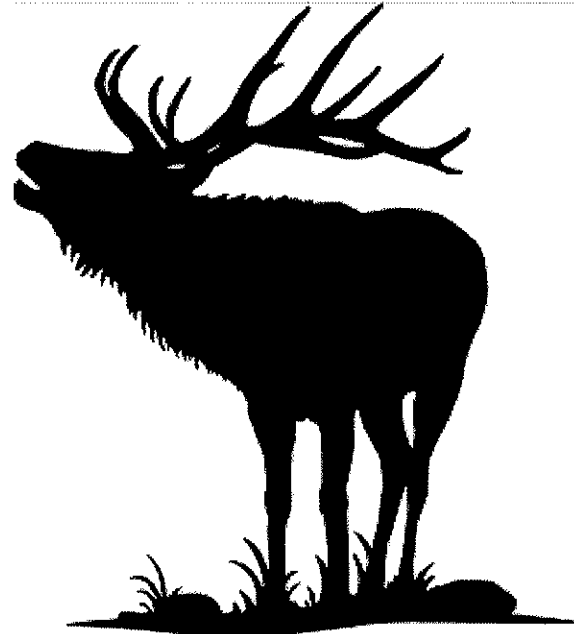

♥ **QUEEN OF HEARTS** ♥

The Lodge continues to run Queen of Hearts as a fundraiser for our building projects and other needs such as Hoop Shoot, Soccer Shoot, Veterans Dinner and many other lodge and community activities.

There are 54 envelopes with all the cards in a deck including the jokers. The envelopes are mixed up, numbered 1 through 54, and then locked in a display case. Each week members (and spouses) can come in and buy tickets for a chance to

select one of the envelopes. Tickets are \$1.00 apiece and there is no limit to how many you can purchase.

Each Tuesday at 7pm, a ticket will be drawn. If the person is present with the winning ticket, they can select the envelope they want to open. If the card in the envelope is the Queen of Hearts, they will win 60% of the Jackpot!

If the person is not present with the winning ticket, they have until the following Monday to come

in and select an envelope but are only eligible for 50% of the prize.

Every card is a winner, ranging from \$10 for cards 2-10 to \$100 for a Joker. The amount of the Jackpot is calculated prior to the drawing and adjusted after the drawing to account for prizes awarded.

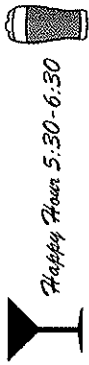
