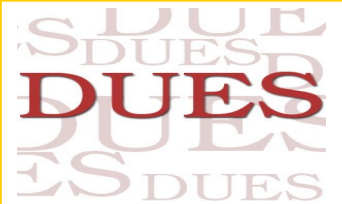
FALL STATE CONVENTION

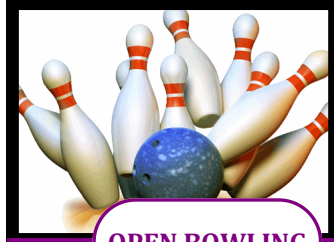
CORNHOLE!

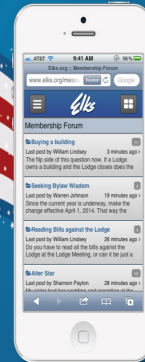
