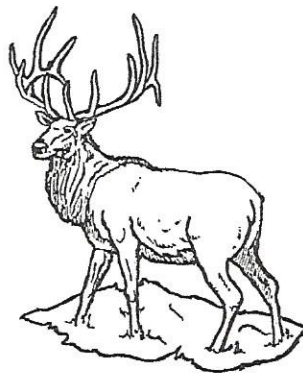

God Bless our Troops and God Bless America!!!

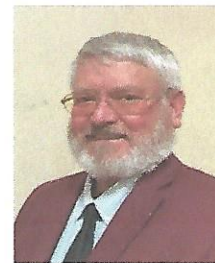

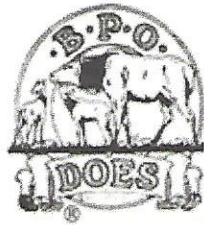

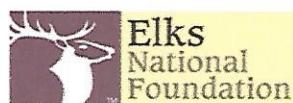
VETERANS REPORT
