The Elks have been busy helping our communities this holiday season. Thousands of financially struggling families will receive food baskets and presents. Elk volunteers will visit thousands of hospitalized Veterans who have protected our freedoms. The Elks vow, "So long as there are veterans, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them." The Elks support both active military forces and Veterans. Elks furnish food, comfort care, therapeutic items, and gifts, host holiday celebrations and recreational activities at bases and hospitals, and stand ready o fulfill any need. ELKS DIAPER BANK

Worland Elks Lodge Community Diaper Bank has been supplying disposable diapers, wipes, and pull-ups to low income families in Washakie and Hot Springs counties since July 1, 2014. Here is how it got started. In late summer of 2013, I had an 18 month old grandson. I was shopping with my daughter and she bought diapers and wipes for her child and it cost her about \$85.00 for a month of supplies. I thought, "Dang! It's a good thing they both have well paying jobs! Then I heard about the diaper bank that was being started for Sweetwater County by United Way Of Southwest WY.

I called the staff at their United Way office and got some information and felt it would be a great thing for our area. I started doing presentations for organizations like the Ministerial Association, Kiwanis Club, the Elks Lodge and I talked about the project to everyone could come up with. I distributed posters to all the churches, health care professionals and local law enforcement offices. We did a few diaper drives and fund raisers, applied for a grant from the Elks National Foundation finally there were enough funds to purchase supplies and get started.



Fast forward 8.5 years and here we are. We still do fund raisers (big yard sales) and apply for grants from the Wyoming State Elks Organization. We have been graced with diaper drives from Cloud Peak Chiropractic, St. Mary Magdalen Church, the Spring Fling organizers, and Washakie County Library. We have received monetary donations from Kiwanis International, Festival of Trees, the Hospital Foundation, St. Alban's Thrift Store, the local

Motorcycle Club, the Does, Hospital Foundation and many individuals.
